Minutes of the meeting

- **E Safety** - Problems getting parents to attend E Safety meetings and ensuring messages are heard. Designated Leads are Mr Mullins, Mrs Blacklock and Mrs Seal. PM discussed issues that are national, local and school based. E Safety issues – grooming occurring nationally and locally. Sexting – sending images of themselves – Snapchat. The peer pressure affecting children. Whatever you put out there stays out there – Digital Tattoo. 90% of employers Google prospective employees. E safety in school was part of Anti Bullying Week etc but after discussion with staff it will now be continually updated. Social Media Policy for all staff, PREVENT strategy – counter terrorism and anti-radicalisation. The idea schools, youth workers etc are looking for signs of pupils being radicalised – Far Right, Religious. There are channels that we can now access if we are concerned. Our job in school to keep everyone aware and refer to Designated Leads. ENCOMPASS – domestic violence – any incidents we will be informed in school. Police will refer to Social Services who inform school immediately. Letter to parents shared. The need now to ensure children and parents are taught about privacy settings. Ideas to share with parents – letters, newsletters, parents evenings, assemblies, website, “How to” session. Videos shown – NSPCC – Share Aware Yrs 5 and 6, Get caught on the web- Year 5 and 6 – better to have real rather than. Last video clip for summer term Year 6. Also put these links onto website and newsletter. Cyberbullying clip if you wouldn't say it in person don't say it.
- **ACTION** - Ideas to share with parents – letters, newsletters, parents evenings, assemblies, website.
- **Behaviour** – JN has been working at a secondary school and has been very impressed at the behaviour and attitudes to learning at Woodstone. There is a need for parents to be aware of behaviours at secondary school. Other parents made comments about how friends/peers affect children.
