Art - garden colour palette
Hopefully you had chance find lots of different flowers and plants yesterday. Today we are going to explore colour in plants and flowers. You may choose to do this in your own garden or out and about around the village. How many different colours can you find in the different plants and flowers that you see? You may choose to just focus on green, in which case look for different shades of green, or you could try to create a rainbow by finding lots of different colours. Create a colour palette by sticking an example (e.g. a leaf or a petal) of each colour into your home learning book and writing the plant or flower it came from (if you know the name). Make sure you ask an adult before picking anything and wash your hands afterwards.

## Maths

Today we are going to create our information poster all about a plant or flower of our choice. Look back at the 'All about sunflowers' poster we looked at yesterday. Posters should be eye-catching, include lots of facts and have different sections each with its own subtitle.
Make sure you include the correct scientific vocabulary and use your neatest, joined handwriting to make your poster look attractive.

Using your 100 square see whether you can guess the number based on three clues given by your adult e.g. my number is less than 50 , more than 40 and is a multiple of 5 .
