In English during this topic, we'll be covering:

- Writing a 3<sup>rd</sup> person narrative, recounting the eruption of Mt Vesuvius and the destruction of Pompeii.
- Shape poetry describing erupting volcanoes.
- Writing our own newspaper report.
- Writing a set of instructions in the form of an informative poster.

This term in **Maths** we'll finish our topic in **Money** before developing our understanding of **Multiplication and Division.** We'll also work on developing our 3, 4, and 8 times tables.

In **Science** we'll be looking at **Rocks!** We'll be looking at different types of rocks and learning about how they were formed. We'll also learn about how fossils are formed when living things are trapped in rock.

In **R.E.** we'll continue to look at how The Bible guides people's decisions.

In our **Geography** lessons we'll learn about volcanoes, earthquakes and tsunamis, how they're formed and the effects they have on the environment. We'll also learn about the locations of Earth's active volcanoes, and about the destruction of Pompeii.

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In **French** our topic is all about food! We'll learn the vocabulary for a range of food, to express likes and dislikes, and to count in French.

In **Art** and **D/T**, we'll be developing our sculpture skills. We'll use clay and other materials to design and develop our own erupting volcano!
