Food, map, landmarks, famous people etc.</p> 	<p><u>Quiz</u></p> <p>Design a quiz for your family. You will need to think of a set of question and answers which can be grouped into categories. Perhaps you could include forfeits or bonus question ideas.</p>	<p><u>Practise your arithmetic skill-</u> Can you hold a family competition? Could you cook a meal or bake something for your family to share?</p>	<p><u>Portraits and Photography-</u></p> <p>Take portrait photographs of your family members or nature from your garden, considering light and textures. Can you use the photographs to draw portraits considering light and tone?</p> 	 <p><u>Hand Written Letters</u></p> <p>Write a letter to a friend, family member or maybe a lonely person in a care home to cheer them up. Perhaps you could include a drawing or something you have made?</p>	<p><u>Organise an treasure hunt</u></p> <p>A proper one- not like Miss Daley's April Fool! There are lots on the internet to help but organise and write a scavenger hunt or a clue based treasure hunt for the whole family.</p>	<p><u>Create some Easter crafts</u></p> <p>Maybe an Easter bonnet, or bunny crafts. Have a look online for some inspiration!</p>
<p><u>History/ Geography</u></p> <p>Go on a virtual tour around a zoo or a museum. Lots of places are offering this at the minute for free, search somewhere that interests you on Google and enjoy!</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Write your own song/rap about a topic of your choice! Maybe you could film yourself in a music video for it?</p>	<p><u>Write an amazon book review.</u></p> <p>What book have you read and loved recently? First write a book review and edit it before adding your own review on Amazon - *Please be mindful of protecting your identities online - never give out your full name or any personal details or information.</p>	<p><u>Time to Talk:</u></p> <p>Play a board game, facetime a member of your family they have not seen this week, enjoy a family indoor picnic or have a family dinner.</p> 	<p><u>Music from the Past</u></p> <p>Research music from the decade your parents, grandparents or other older family members were born. What were the most popular bands or singers during this time? Can you perform a song from this decade and create your very own dance routine?</p>
