

In **English** we'll be looking at:

- Writing character profiles about Greek Gods
- Writing our own diary extract
- Creating a set of instructions
- Writing a persuasive argument
- Writing expressive letters to a king
- Listening to and writing up an interview with a special guest
- Writing descriptive paragraphs about mythical beasts

In **Maths** we'll continue with our **multiplication and division**, looking at multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers. We'll also look at counting and using **money**.

Our **Science** topic this term is *Light!* We'll be learning about different light sources, how light reflects from different surfaces, how shadows are formed and why shadows change size. We'll also look at how to keep safe in the sun!

During **History** we'll be learning about Ancient Greece. We'll look at the different city-states of Ancient Greece and learn about the soldiers that fought in their wars. In **Music** we will start to look at pitch. We'll also carry on with our recorder lessons.

In **PSHE** we'll be learning about using our own strengths to work well with others.

- Looking at the geography of Greece and learning about the different city-states that ruled.
- Learning about the alphabet that the ancient Greeks used.
