- Using similes, metaphors and personification to improve our creative writing

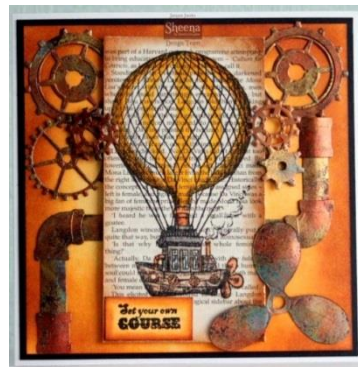
In **Maths** we will be learning about:
