

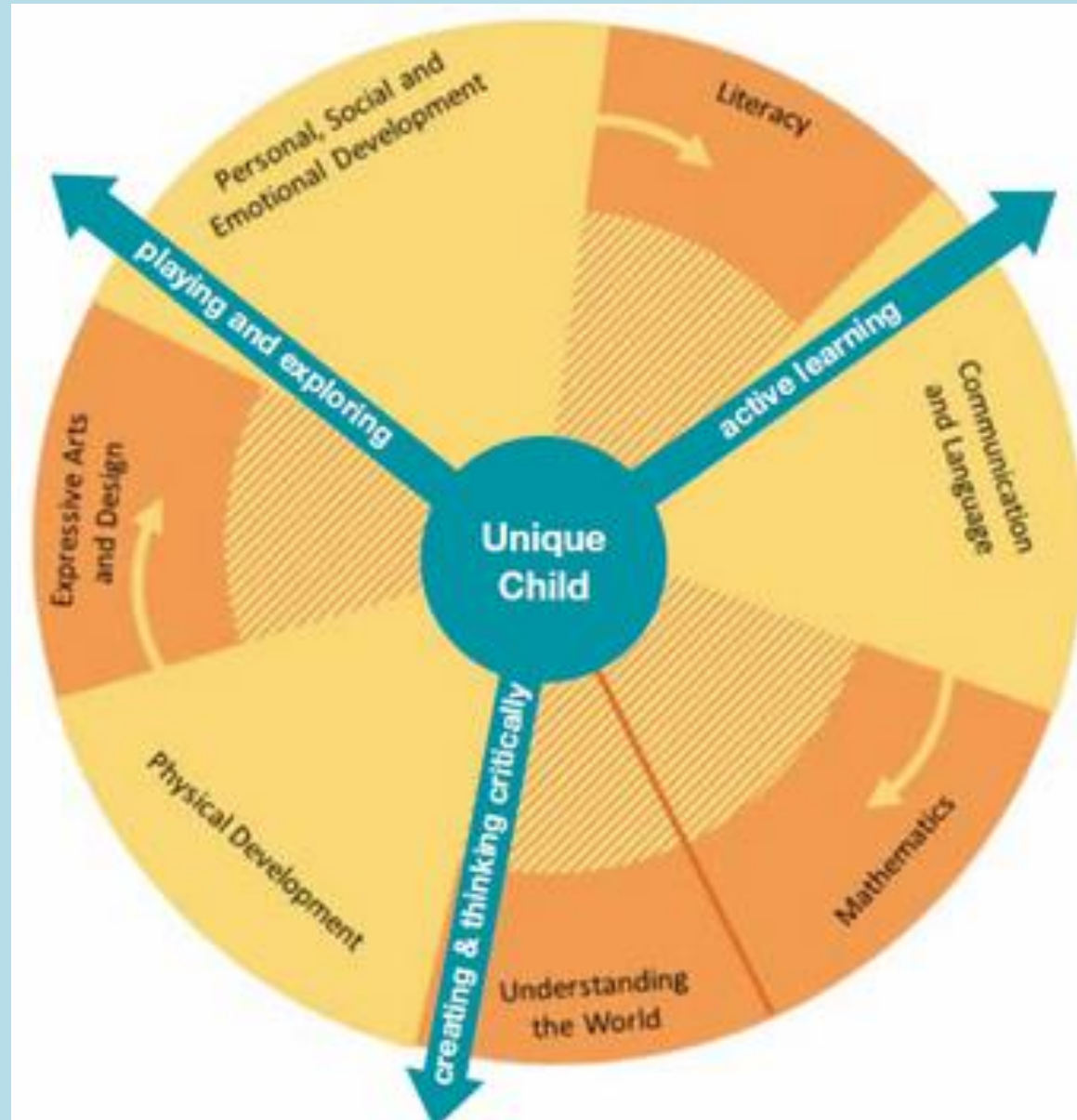

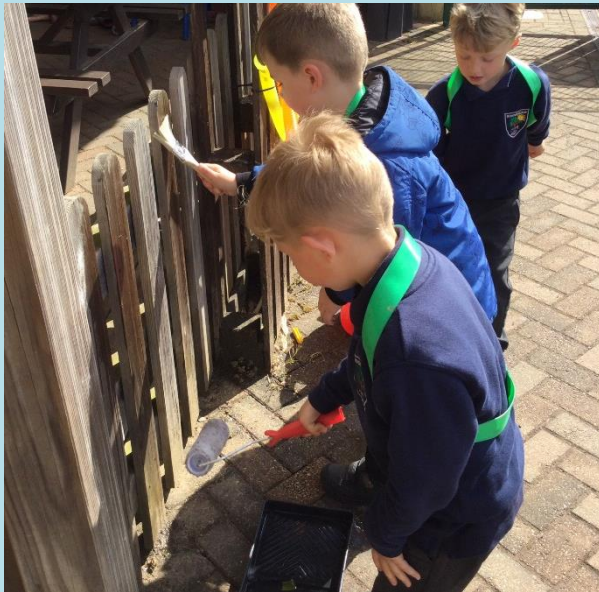

- Please make sure everything is named




Reading

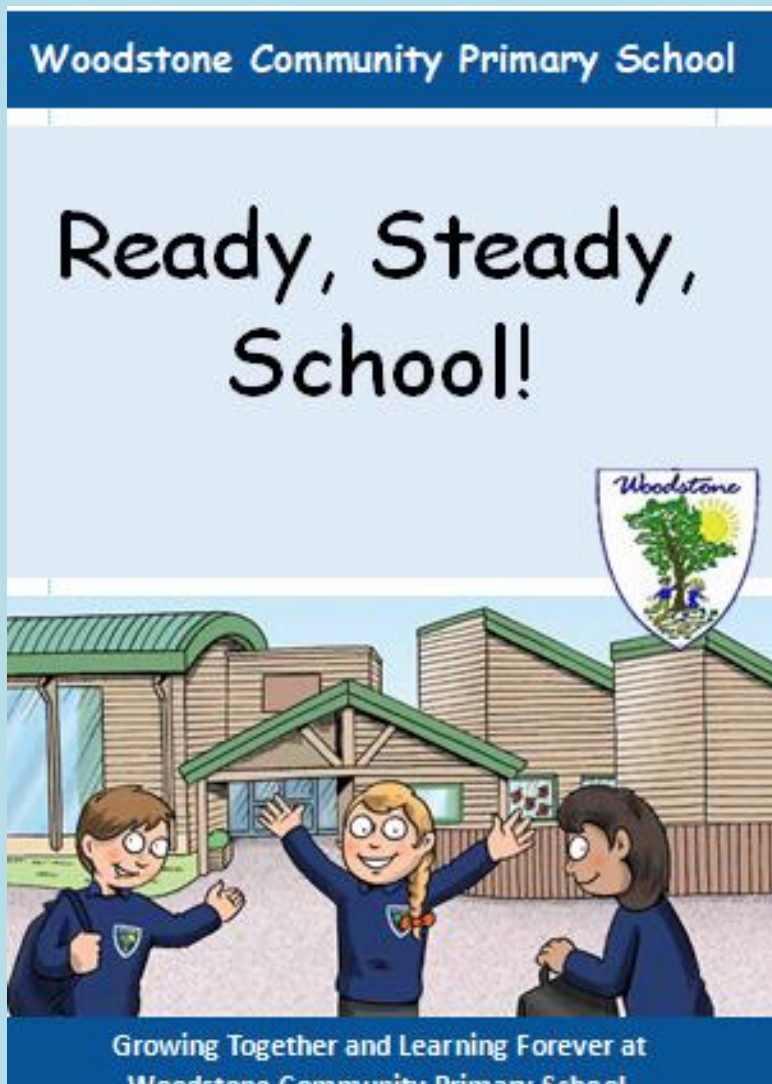

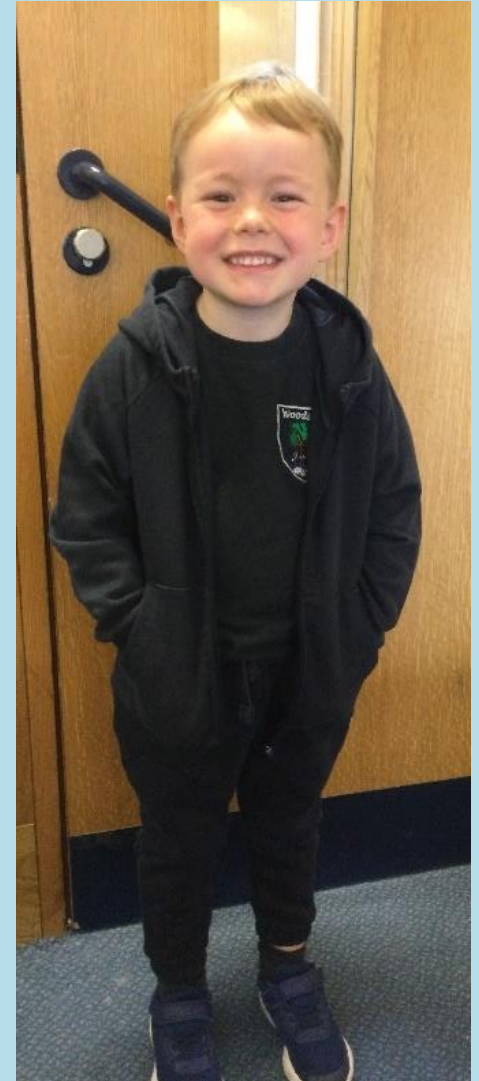
P.E. kit
