

In **English** during this topic, we'll be covering:

In **R.E.** we'll continue to look at how The Bible guides people's decisions. We'll also begin to discuss why people pray.

In **Science** we'll be looking at **Rocks!** We'll be looking at different types of rocks and learning about how they were formed. We'll also learn about how fossils are formed when living things are trapped in rock.
