Year 3 Curriculum Map - Autumn 2

This half term in English we'll focus on:

- Non-chronological reports
- Writing explanations
- Writing detailed instructions
- Using our new knowledge about metals to create list poems
- Creating our own recounts from a different perspective.

In Maths, we'll be continuing our work with addition and subtraction of 3-digit numbers. As well as beginning to explore multiplication and division. We will also continue to practice our 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

This half-term, PSHE will focus on recognising and managing emotions. In R.E. we'll be learning about different Christian festivals and why they're important to us. In our science lessons we'll learn all about forces and magnets! We'll discuss different forces such as friction, gravity and magnetic force. We'll also observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials.

In our topic lessons we will be:

- Learning about different types of metals and their properties.
- Going on a magnetic object hunt.
- Creating art using foil embossing techniques.
- We'll also create a large metal friend for the Iran Man, one of the characters in our book this term, The Iron Man by Ted Hughes.

Our music lessons will continue with our previous work with rhythm and using our voice as an instrument

In our P.E. lessons we'll continue to develop our running and team work skills through creative games. We'll also be developing our balance and strength in gymnastics.
