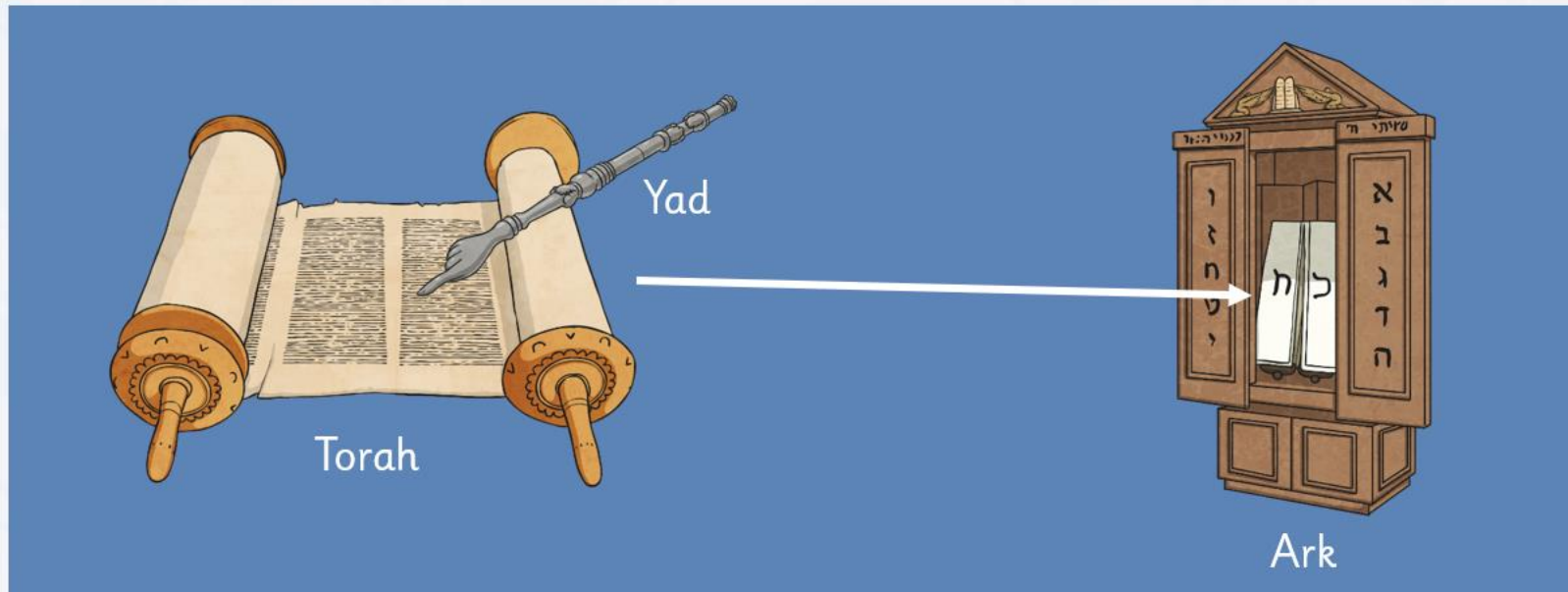

The Torah is stored inside the Ark of the Covenant in the Synagogue and no one is allowed to touch it, so a Yad is used to read it.
