Welcome back! We hope you had a wonderful Christmas and a very Happy New Year. A huge thank you for all the lovely cards and presents we received – you were incredibly generous...thank you.

Just a couple of points to note for this term:

- The children will be visiting the school library every week where they will be able to borrow books to take home. - We will be continuing with our Reading Raffle. Please encourage your child to read at least five times a week to be entered.
- The children will have P.E. on Thursday this half term, where they will be developing their ball skills. However, please ensure they have a named P.E. kit in school **all week** in case of timetable changes. Please check this includes a named pair of pumps and trainers.
- The children will continue to take part in Forest School every Friday morning so please ensure they have an appropriate kit in school which is named.
- Please continue to ensure that children's water bottles are named and contain water (not juice).
