This half term we will be continuing to work on our counting focusing on the numbers from 0-5. We will also begin to think about one more and one less as well as measurements such as time.

Communication and Language

Physical Development

This half term we will be continuing to learn and develop confidence with our Phase 2 phonics. We will be introducing new sounds and tricky words that the children can begin to use within their reading and writing.

Understanding the World
