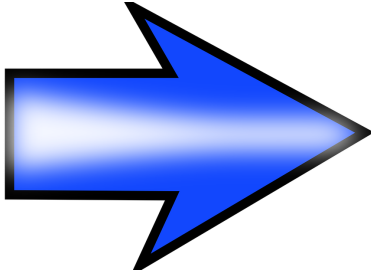

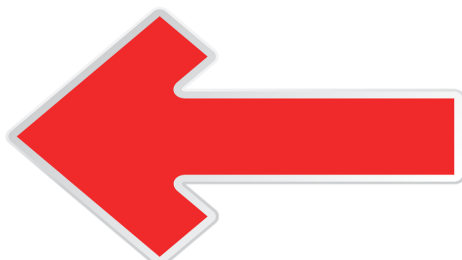

Did you know that we have our very own school lottery. This is a professionally run lottery and happens in lots of schools around the country.

Tickets for the lottery can be bought by anyone at all who wishes to help us with our fundraising project – this could be family, friends, colleagues from anywhere in the country. We want to sell, if possible, 200 tickets per week as this would generate £5000 per year for our project and help us towards our fundraising total of £45,000. Tickets are only £1 each (less than the national lottery) and supporters can have as few or as many as they wish. Indeed, many people set up a monthly direct debit which ensures they don't forget.
