Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back. We hope you had a wonderful Easter. We are really looking forward to welcoming the children back to an exciting and busy term!

Our topic for this half term is 'On the Farm' and after the half term holiday, we will be thinking about the topic of 'What Can You See in Summer'. Over the term we will be revising and consolidating key learning in both Maths and English. In Maths we will be developing our knowledge and understanding of addition and subtraction, measurement and numerical patterns and also exploring patterns. In our English and Phonics sessions we will continue to reinforce both Phase 2 and Phase 3 phonics. Children will be encouraged to challenge themselves to write independently using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Just a couple of points to note for this term:



- •The children will continue to visit the School library where they will be able to borrow books to take home. Please could you ensure the children's library books (these are the ones with the barcode inside the front cover) are back in school on a Monday morning so they can be changed in our weekly library slot.
- The children will continue to bring home their 'Maths Challenge' books on a Thursday. This needs to be returned back to School by the following Wednesday.
- This half term the children will have their weekly swimming lesson on a Tuesday afternoon.
 Please ensure normal P.E. kits are still in school all week and check that this includes a named pair of pumps and trainers in case we decide to do an extra P.E session.
- The children will continue to take part in Forest School sessions every Friday so please ensure they have an appropriate kit in school.
- Please continue to ensure that children's water bottles are named and contain water and not juice.
- Please carry on sharing your child's achievements out of school.
