

Maths

In Maths this term we will be developing our understanding of place value up to 100 as well as introducing the concepts of multiplication, division and fractions. We will also learn how to tell the time to o'clock and half-past the hour.

English

In our English lessons this half term we will be exploring and writing stories inspired by our 'Enchanted Woodland' topic, such as 'Hansel and Gretel', 'The Gruffalo' and 'Mrs Mole I'm Home'. We will continue to work through Phase 5 Phonics focusing on alternative graphemes/phoneme correspondences and continue to develop our pre-cursive letters during handwriting.

Personal, Social and Health Education

This half term in our PSHE lessons we will be learning about our bodies with our 'Relationships and Sex Education' unit.

Computing

This half term in our Computing lessons we will be learning how to create and use spreadsheets.

Music

Our focus in Music this half term is 'Music Technology'. We will be listening to and creating music using technology.

R.E.

This half term in R.E. we will be exploring the unit 'What makes some places sacred?'. We will compare and contrast different special places from a range of religions.

P.E.

In P.E. this half term we will be developing our team work skills with our 'Team Games' unit. We will draw on all of the ball skills we have learnt so far, as well as beginning to understand how to attack and defend.

Science

In Science this half term we will be continuing to build on our learning about seasonal change. We will explore the different seasons in detail, focusing on the key features, weather and day length across the year.

Geography

In Geography this half term we will be learning about weather and climates around the world. We will explore the weather in our country and compare and contrast this to other parts of the world. We will also build on our knowledge of the UK, learning about the four countries and capital cities.

Art and Design

In our Art and D&T lessons this half term we will be developing our understanding of colour mixing, focusing on primary and secondary colours and creating colour wheels. We will also continue to build on our knowledge of sculpture, creating woodlands trees using a range of materials.
