<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this term we will continue to build on our knowledge of place value up to 100 and begin to look at calculations using these numbers. We will further explore multiplication, division and fractions and begin to solve problems using this knowledge.

English

In our English lessons this half term we will be exploring and writing stories inspired by our 'Beside the Seaside' topic, such as 'The Pirates Next Door' and the 'Katie Morag' series of stories. We will continue to work through Phase 5 Phonics focusing on alternative graphemes/phoneme correspondences and continue to develop our pre-cursive letters during handwriting.

<u>P.E.</u>

In P.E. this half term we will be developing our skills in running, jumping and throwing with our Athletics unit. We will learn about different events in athletics and will be using equipment such as batons, foam javelins and Year One Summer Two Curriculum Map

Beside the Seaside

<u>R.E.</u>

This half term in R.E. we will be exploring what it means to belong to a faith community. We will compare and contrast this across different religions.

<u>Music</u>

Our focus in Music this half term is '20th Century Music'. We will be listening to and learning to appreciate different styles of music from the 20th century.

<u>Science</u>

In Science this half term we will be continuing to build on our learning about plants. We will further explore the different parts of a plant, learn about what plants need to grow and spend time exploring the plants in our woodland.

Geography

In Geography this half term we will be learning about the UK, revisiting the capital cities and surrounding seas we have already been learning about and exploring of the physical geographical features of the coastline of the UK. We will also be learning about some seaside towns in the UK, such as Scarborough.

History

In our History lessons this half term we will be developing an understanding of changes within living memory, focusing on holidays. We will explore the great British seaside holiday and compare and contrast this with holidays today, focusing on pastimes, food and transport.

<u>Computing</u> This half term in our Computing lessons we will be exploring the use of technology in everyday life outside of school.
