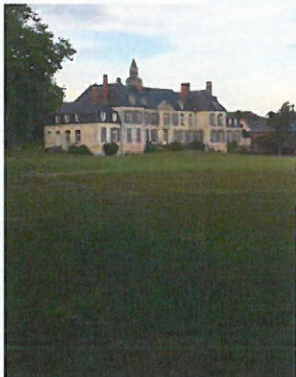

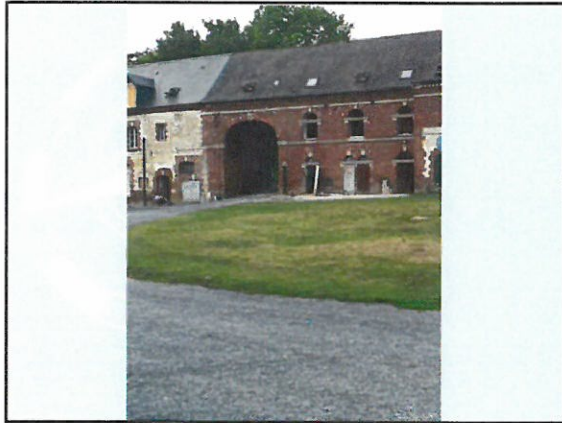

- Exclusive use of a luxury POD Village



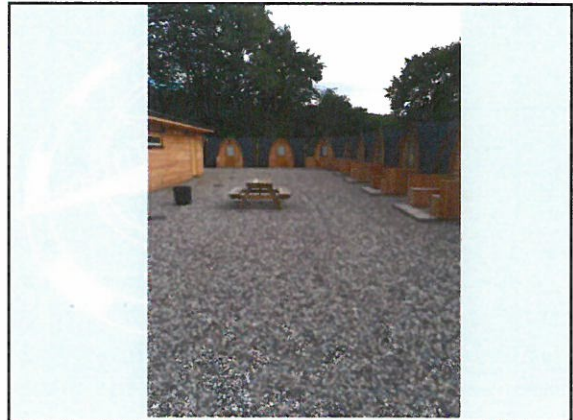


Château de Warsy

- 96% re-booking levels

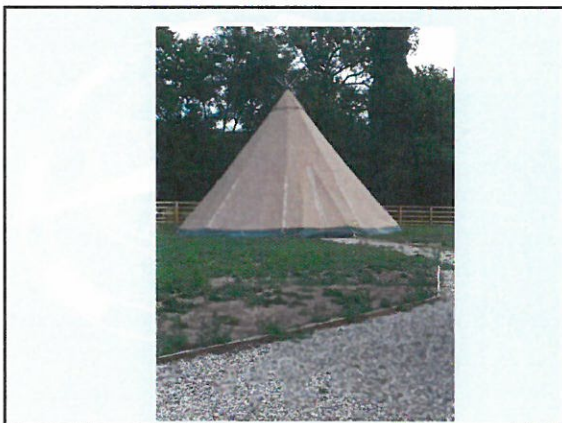
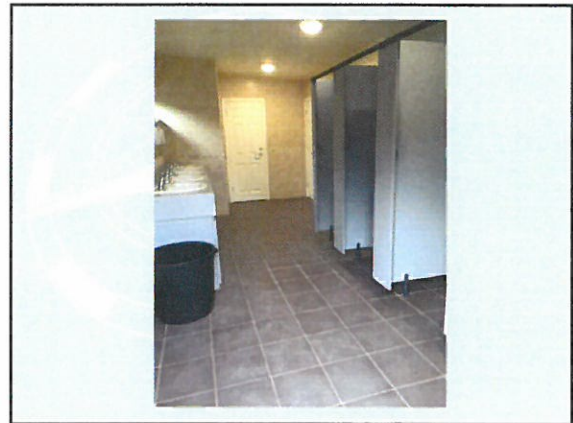
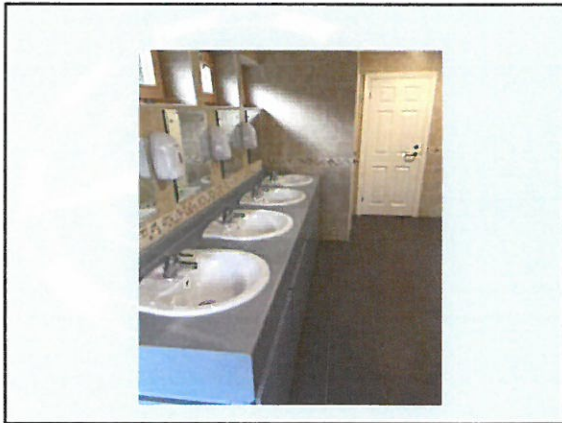
POD Village

- A concept developed by Manor Adventure
- Luxury camping experience for schools. Pupils are accommodated in 4 bedded PODs with heating and electricity
- Teachers in amongst the children with their own POD.
- Superbly fitted out toilet/shower blocks form part of the village.
- Teacher rooms adjacent to students rooms
- Duty Instructor per building (24 hours)
- Schools stay together: eat, sleep and do activities



SECURITY

- Locks in each pod
- Chateau grounds surrounded by high wall
