ATTENDANCE

Our overall attendance at Woodstone for this term is 95.2%

Our overall attendance for the whole year (so far) is 95.4% (94.6%)

(National figures in brackets)

Persistent Absence (PA) - Children classed as 'persistently absent' are those who have attendance of 90% or less. It is pleasing to see that this number has reduced to 13 children but this is still too many. Let's hope during the last term of the year we can see this reduced further.

It is important to remember that we have 175 non-school days so we need to remind you that holidays/family days/shopping days/visits should be taken during these days not the 190 days the children should be in school.

By the end of the academic year if a child only attends:

90% this equates to 19 school days missed!

85% equates to 28.5 school days missed!

80% equates 38 school days missed!
