Mathematics

This half term we will be focusing on addition and subtraction to 10. We will start by looking at combining two objects to make a whole. We will then look at our number bonds to 10 using a ten's frame and the part-whole model. a

Literacy

This half term we will be exploring lots of traditional tales, such as The Three Little Pigs and Jack and the Beanstalk. We will be spending time thinking about the structure of a story and creating our own versions of some of these traditional stories. We will be storytelling in groups and putting on our own puppet show to re-tell the stories.

Expressive Arts and Design
