Governors play a vital role in the running of the school, strategically not on a day to day basis.

In 2014 under government regulations we reconstituted; this meant operating with smaller numbers, having the right skills for the job, which in turn created a new structure. We are a mix of Local Authority, Parent, School and Co-opted Governors and come from all walks of life.

The Full Governing Body (FGB) meets up to 6 times per academic year and also has a group training session. Other meetings include sub-committee meetings (Standards & Achievements, Leadership & Management and Safety, Welfare & Behaviour).

Every Governor is allocated a committee and those on Standards & Achievements committee have a subject area to represent in which they make visits into school. These visits are time consuming so governors with availability are allocated more.

Governors are encouraged to make regular visits into school both to see assemblies, concerts and performances as well as to make curriculum linked visits and to experience the day to day running of the school.
