
Phonics Screen Check - Year Two

Dear Parents/Carers,

As mentioned in our latest class newsletter, the phonics screening check for Year One children across the country was cancelled last year due to the Covid restrictions which means our current Year Two children did not take the check in Year One. The Department for Education has made it statutory for schools to administer a phonics screening check to Year 2 pupils during this autumn term instead. Therefore, I would like to outline what the check is, how it will be administered and what you can do at home to support your child with their phonics.

What is the Phonics Screening Check?

The phonics screening checks are designed to confirm whether children have learnt sufficient phonic decoding and blending skills to an appropriate standard. The check is comprised of a list of 40 words which children are asked to read aloud. The list is a combination of 20 real words and 20 non-words which the children refer to as 'alien-words' or 'nonsense-words'. These non-words such as 'vap' and 'jound' are included in the check as they rely purely on using phonics for decoding. These words will contain a picture of an alien next to them as seen in the image below.



When will the Phonics Screening Check take place?

Year Two children at Woodstone will complete the check the week beginning Monday 8th November while the children are still feeling refreshed from their half-term break and before the excitement/tiredness of Christmas begins! I will be administering the check with the children in our quiet room on a one-to-one basis. I will aim to complete the checks during the morning sessions and towards the beginning of the week. Every child will receive a certificate and sticker for their participation which will also inform you they have completed the check.

When will I receive my child's results?

After all the screening checks have taken place and the scores have been submitted to the local authority, we will inform you of your child's scores and whether they met the expected standard or not. The children who did not meet the expected standard will be given the opportunity to repeat the test in June 2022 when our current Year One children complete their statutory check.























How can I support my child at home?

- Practise reading the words on the lists attached which contain real and nonsense words.
- Encourage your child to decode nonsense words by saying each sound (not letter) in the word from left to right. Ask your child to repeat the sounds, getting faster until they are able to hear the word and blend the sounds together.
- Ask children to spot digraphs (two letters that make one sound for example, sh, th, ch) and trigraphs (three
 letters that make one sound for example, 'ear', 'igh', 'air') in words.
- Practise identifying the sound families (alternative spellings for the same sound) using the sounds mats
 available on the Year Two class page on the website. This is particularly useful when children are reading
 real words. For example, children need to know the 'ch' can sometimes make the 'sh' sound like in the
 word 'chef'. We encourage children to change the way they have said a sound, using their sound family
 knowledge, if the word doesn't sound quite right to them.
- Play on phonics games available on www.phonicsplay.co.uk
- Encourage your child to read as often as possible!


